

District 86 Council Meeting <u>District Director's Report</u> -- April 22, 2023



*Toastmasters International has reduced the membership net growth of new, dual or reinstated members from 5 to 3 this year. This is your year to achieve Distinguished club Status.

Five or more Distinguished Club Goals (DCP) by June 30th, 2023.

Meet the required number of club members or have 20 members by June $30^{\mbox{\scriptsize th}}.$

• Net growth of 3 members (new, dual or reinstated) Examples:

On July $1^{st},$ the club had 7 members, on June 30^{th} the club has 10 members.

On July $1^{\mbox{\scriptsize st}},$ the club had 20 members, on June $30^{\mbox{\scriptsize th}}$ the club has 20 members.



As of March 30, 2023, 10 clubs in District 86 have met the membership requirement (April to September dues paid to Toastmasters International) and have 5 or more DCP goals. Through April, May and June more and more clubs will achieve Distinguished status.

Many clubs have 5 or more DCP and still need membership to achieve distinguished or higher status. Plesae utilize the membership incentives by June 30, 2023 in your journey to Club Distinguished status.

Club Growth Director Paid Clubs

A paid club has 8 or more members. As of March 30, 2023, District 86 has 123 Paid clubs. In March 2023, 3 new corporate clubs were chartered.

Membership Payments

As of March 30, 2023, District 86 has 3624 membership payments paid to Toastmasters International. Members are encouraged to continue developing through the Toastmasters Program. Renew your membership by paying April to September membership dues.

Many clubs in District 86 are poised to achieve Distinguished status with the lower net 3 membership growth of new, dual or reinstated members. Clubs are strongly encouraged to embrace this opportunity. Also, members and clubs should utilize the <u>membership incentives</u> by June 30, 2023 to grow membership and achieve Distinguished status.
